



Marsudi Wahyu Kisworo is a Professor in Computer Science. He is the first Indonesian holding the title in 2002. He was born in Kediri, on the 29th of Oktober, 1958. He obtained his first degree from the Department of Electrical Engineering, Institut Teknologi Bandung majoring Controls and Computer Engineering. In 1989 he was awarded Master scholarships from IDP Australia (later then transferred to AIDAB). In 1992 he finished his doctorate program and was awarded Doctor of Philosophy in Computer Science, Curtin University of Technology, Australia in 1993. Besides being an academics, he is also holding several certificate such as Professional Engineer (Advanced Level), Enterprise Risk Management (Advanced Level), Enterprise Architect, Cybersecurity and cyberdefense, etc.

He has also experienced in several top management positions in private companies, state own company, as well as top positions in university management. Currently he is holding the position as the Rector/Vice Chancellor of Perbanas Institute for the second term.

For social contribution, he has conducted “Inspiring Teacher” training to more than

400.000 teachers in more than 350 kabupaten/kota in Indonesia. This training is based on his best selling book “Revolusi Mengajar”.
